

The 100-point 1982 Mouton Rothschild has moved beyond its youthful style that existed during its first 25 years of life, which yielded to a bouquet of secondary nuances as cedar and spice box. The crème de cassis, underlying floral note, full-bodied power, extraordinary purity, multilayered texture, and finish of over a minute showcase what this Château accomplished in 1982.

Robert Parker suggests that it is certainly capable of remaining fruity and vibrant in until 2082. This is a great wine, filled with complexity and brilliance.



is. There's composure and elegance throughout these wines, and even at this point in time—54 years old!—they show their deep berry fruit with layers of earth, mushroom and roses. In particular, the 100-point Château Latour offers a regal perfume of tobacco leaf, cassis, iron, cedar, spice, truffle and forest floor notes. Powerful, full bodied, intense and deep, this concentrated wine takes over the palate with multiple layers of rich, ripe, spicy black fruits that fill the mouth and coat the palate. Latour 1961 personifies the term "iron fist in a velvet glove." This is elegance meshed with power.





With its slogan 'The Wine Of Kings, The King Of Wines,' Château Gruaud Larose revels in its celebrated status in the compact, cru classé-concentrated appellation of Saint-Julien, the smallest of the Médoc's famous regions. Gruaud Larose's 82 hectares of vines add up to almost 10% of all Saint-Julien's vineyards. Starting with the 1982, a wine that shows impressive concentration with polish and pure expressions of licorice, cassis and plum, the following vintages in this extraordinary vertical shine as well, with unparallelled provenance.

Château Gruaud Larose offers an outstandingly unique bottle to complete this lot: an original Gruaud Larose 1865 bottle which was retrieved from the icy depths of the Sea, and refilled by the Château with their ultra-premium Gruaud Larose 2000.

In February 1872, a ship called the Marie-Therese left Bordeaux bound for Saigon (now Ho Chi Minh City) in Vietnam carrying 2,000 bottles of 1865 Gruaud Larose. The vessel sank in a storm in the Gaspar Straits in Indonesia. One hundred and twenty years later, several hundred of the bottles were brought to the surface. Included in this lot is one of the original bottles from 1865, now refilled with Ch. Gruaud Larose 2000. This vintage features "absolutely wonderful aromas of flowers, currants and citrus. Full-bodied, yet very, very refined, with a center core of fruit that tastes like crushed raspberries and goes on and on. Greatest wine from this estate since 1945," according to Wine Spectator. We'll drink to that!



Wine Spectator underscored this wine's legendary status by selecting Heitz Wine Cellars Martha's Vineyard Cabernet as one of the Top 12 wines of the 20th Century. The 1997 vintage is a stunning example of copious black currant fruit intermixed with soil and mild pleasant undertones of licorice. The wine is medium to full-bodied, pure, ripe and nicely-textured with a lengthy finish. In the mouth, the Cabernet fruit is wonderfully balanced with firm tannins, and the richness of layers adds to the complexity and intrigue.

hen Bill Harlan purchased 230 acres in Napa Valley in 1984, he clearly expressed his ambition to "create a first growth wine." Only 38 acres are cultivated with grape varieties Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Limited production, consistent acclaim from Wine Spectator and Robert Parker—including four scores of 100!— have cemented the wine's "Cult" status. Bidders take note: This is not an easy wine to get your hands on.

A blend of 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, with the rest Merlot and Cabernet Franc, 1997 Harlan is enormously-endowed and profoundly rich. Opaque purple in color, its soaring aromatics of vanilla, minerals, coffee, blackberries, licorice, and cassis are down right exuberant. In the mouth, layer after layer unfold powerfully yet gently with the acidity, tannin, and alcohol in harmonious balance. 100 points hardly seem adequate. The elongated finish goes on and on and the aging potential is unparalleled, making this drinkable far into the 2030s.

The Next of Kyn Cumulus Vineyard Syrah is an extremely expressive wine, deep in color with sweet notes of cassis, acacia flowers, licorice and a hint of pepper. It's wildly intense with a full-bodied texture that is sure to please. The immense purity of the fruit gives the 2009 tons of elegance and character and at the same time, big, rich, silky tannins. This blend of 80% Syrah, 14% Grenache and 6% Roussanne is shaping up to show its expressiveness and pedigree.

This Is Not An Exit Estate Syrah is a similar blend, with fruit from his Santa Rita Hills Eleven Confessions Vineyard plus a classic 1% dose of Viognier. The fruit bursts with rich kirsch, flower oil, smoked meats, licorice and graphite. It then hits the palate with intense richness, depth and loads of fruit with a blockbuster finish.

Sine Qua Non Esto No Es Una Salida Estate Grenache benefits from a short half hour of decanting to allow the deep ruby colored concentrated wine to breathe. You'll maximize the aromas of black currant and cassis, and the lively flavors of blackberry and raisin.

ot sure you'll find any Grey in this lot, but you'll find every other shade here. This outstanding lot shows inky black to ruby to brilliant golden.

Michel Chapoutier is one of the most highly regarded winemakers in the world. Since taking over his family firm in 1990 at age 26, he has transformed the winery into the leading Rhône Valley producer. Chapoutier's family dates back to 1808, and their wines benefit from their deep knowledge of the land.

The De l'Orée 1994—an impressive 99-point wine—is intense golden yellow in color with a nose that can give fruity lemon with floral overtones of acacia and hawthorn. It has a well-rounded, full bodied mouthfeel. Robert Parker notes that in 1997, Michel Chapoutier introduced a luxury cuvée of white Hermitage called Le Méal. It displays, in addition to cherry notes, an orange Grand Marnier characteristic to its fruit. It is an immense, full-bodied, fabulously powerful and concentrated dry white with a steely finish. There are only 300 or so cases of this wine produced annually.

In the 2001 l'Ermite you will find the Ermitage's oldest vines put to great use. Limpid straw yellow in color, this very round, rich wine will bring an elegant balance with just a light bitterness at the finish.




The dance of the white wines ends in 2003 for our two vineyards. The magnum of 2003 Le Méal is extremely rare in this format and a wonderful effort to be savored. The 2003 De l'Orée shines brightly. The full-bodied white wine has a most beautiful bouquet of liquid minerals, citrus, honeysuckle and a tropical hint.

A quick word about our red wines in this lot. Two Syrah—Le Pavillon and l'Ermite Syrah— typify the absolute best of the region. The 2005 l'Ermite is so full and round that it's expected to keep its fruit for up to 60 years, full of dark red fruit, a hint of white pepper and ethereal minerality. The black/blue-colored 2000 Ermitage Le Pavillon is brilliant out of the bottle. Notes of graphite, ink, licorice, crème de cassis, and minerals jump from the glass of this syrup of Hermitage. Full-bodied, unctuously-textured, gorgeously rich, spectacularly concentrated and long, it is a tour de force in winemaking.

Note: Ermitage Blanc, Le Méal 1998 has a torn label and 4 bottles of Ermitage Rouge, Le Pavillon 2000 have slightly torn labels.

Blue, black, yellow, red. Still no Grey, but this is an impressive 50 Shades of the wine-kind, and a Rhône dynasty in the making.

Those who cherish the power and perfume of classic Hermitage know that some of the greatest examples come from the Jean-Louis Chave family cellars. The family dates back to 1481 in the Northern Rhône region of Hermitage, continuing a five-century dynasty of extraordinarily high quality and pure expression of the region.

The beauty and complexity found in JL Chave Hermitage is in their masterful blending. The only grape used in their red wine is Syrah, but the wine is produced from a melange of the top sources in the appellation. Many Syrah add up to be greater than the sum of their individual parts.

The wines show a nice nose of black tea, black olive tapenade, smoky meat and earth notes. They are certainly wines of great depth and structure, drinking very nicely right now but will benefit even more from another decade. The 1990 is the bigger wine in the group, with huge and explosive flavors on the palate yet amazing polish and even more balance than the earlier vintages.

And, the fabulous 1994 Côte Rôtie La Landonne has a dense dark purple color, with aromas of olive, iron and black fruit.

The 1945 Graham Vintage Port is a rare, rare treat. As Richard Mayson, the Decanter World Wine Awards Regional Chair for Port, notes, it is "among the finest vintage Ports declared this [20th] century". *Decanter's* veteran columnist Michael Broadbent declared in 1989 that it was 'outstandingly the loveliest' of the 1945 vintage Ports. A spectacular finish, indeed.

Château Haut-Brion wines have an unmistakable nobility and a burgeoning complexity. This 1995 is majestic and still drinking young with a harmony between the very soft and very fine structure. Wine Journal with Neal Martin likens it to the "lovely 1982." One can enjoy it now but there are still mostly primary flavours here with only hints of the cigar, leather and sweet spices that dominate Haut-Brion's mature wines. Tannins are velvety and supple with flavours that linger for a long time on the finish. It has great charm, and Robert Parker praises the brilliant winemaker Jean-Bernard Delmas for his handling of the vintage. Drink one now, and every year for the next 11 years. Sounds like a good plan to us, but we're not sure we could be that patient.



THE AMBASSADOR'S FAVORITES

hese twelve bottles are a decadent tour of Bordeaux's best properties in mature vintages. Of the first growths, 1981 Margaux was given 95 points by Wine Spectator, and stands the test of time for elegance and longevity. As has perhaps been mentioned previously, 1982 Pichon Lalande is a 100-point bottle of perfection. The 1995 La Mission Haut-Brion, Margaux, and Latour would make for an outstanding horizontal tasting experience. Each of these wines is in its prime, and all scored strongly in the 95-96 point range for Parker. Latour is a particular favorite of Robert Parker. "A beauty, the opaque dense purplecolored 1995 exhibits jammy cassis, vanillin, and minerals in its fragrant but still youthful aromatics. Medium to full-bodied, with exceptional purity, superb concentration, and a long, intense, ripe, 40-second finish, this is a magnificent example of Latour."







Marcassin and phenomenal winemaker Helen Turley absolutely shine year in and year out. The 2008 is deemed one of the two or three most profound Chardonnays made in California, ever. This 100-point wine would stand proudly at any tasting of white Burgundies. It's unquestionably the Chardonnay of the Vintage boasting great acid, phenomenal concentration and staggering length. Drink it now or lay it down until 2026. You won't forget this one.



Harlan 2000 is "a stupendous wine that epitomizes the Harlan style of grace and power," raves Wine Enthusiast. Hundred Acre wines are made by sorting the fruit berry by berry, fermented in small French oak fermenters, and long aging in the finest barriques. The vineyard is located at the base of Howell Mountain in the stunning St. Helena, land that is composed of volcanic soil strata that benefits from a 180 degree arc of the sun. The 100% Cabernet Sauvignon Kayli Morgan 2009 is a great showing. This wine is generous and textured with layers of dark red fruit, espresso, new leather and spices. High-toner floral notes and the silkiest of tannins frame the striking finish. The ARK 2009 is a huge win: dense and rich but dry, with highly concentrated, complex flavors of plum, chocolate, tobacco and woodsmoke. An intense deep wine with dark red fruit, flowers, mint, licorice and exotic spices are some of the many notes that flow from this fabulously textured Cabarnet Sauvignon.

The nose of **2001 Grace Family Vineyard** is explosive, big, spicy, black currant. It has great balance and very good medium weighted mouthfeel. Sweet intense flavors of black currants and dark plums make this a substantial wine, delicious and also with remarkable structure.

Round this off with the 100-point perfect scoring 2007

Scarecrow, with huge aromas of ripe currant, plum and blackberry, with a dash of mocha-laced oak. This massive-bodied dark beauty gives off lovely floral scents, has the most elegant structure then finishes firmly with length. Its perfect balance suggests it can be drunk at a relatively young age, but it should easily evolve over 30-35 years.

Vineyard specialist Annie Favia, who herself spent a decade working with David Abreu, convinced her husband Andy Erickson (winemaker for Dalla Valle, Ovid, Dancing Hares and Arietta with past stints at Screaming Eagle, Staglin, and Harlan—for some serious name-dropping!) to set up shop in Coombsville.

The Cabernet, which is 50% made of Oakville fruit, still has the mark of this stellar winemaking team, but the warmer climate grapes giving it a fuller body and mildly longer finish. Altogether, this Favia Collection offers endless "Coombsvillian" pleasure.

And then there's **SLOAN 2000** is the inaugural vintage, and only 310 cases were produced this year. It's insanely dense, powerful, and typical of the Napa style Cabernet produced. These bottles of Château Pavie 2003 are a deep crimson color which borders on black. The nose reflects the hot vintage, with a very concentrated bouquet of blackberry, juicy cherries, jam, and a touch of understated toasty aromas that frame the ripe fruit. It's a powerful and rich beauty, with a suave texture with a certain overripe quality giving an impression of sweetness in an otherwise dry wine. Parker found it to be youthful and rich with terrific purity and texture as well as a striking opulence, hence the almost perfect score of 99 points. The lively acidity also adds to the depth while excellent, firm tannins underpin the concentration and richness. This Pavie will benefit greatly from decanting ahead of time to allow it to unveil its many charms.

One of the oldest Médoc wine estates, Château Léoville-Las-Cases's *terroir* has been at the heart of their exquisite wines since the 17th century. A wine prepared for serious aging, the 2010 Château Léoville-Las-Cases is a full-bodied classic Bordeaux. Opaque purple in color, this big, concentrated, thick wine is stuffed with ripe cassis and fresh blackberries. Powerful, tannic, ripe, fresh and dense, this masculine wine requires serious cellar time to become civilized. If its 100-point ranking from *Wine Enthusiast* is any indication, the cellar time will be worth it.



The blend in 2000 was 93% Cabernet Sauvignon and 7% Merlot, creating both extreme power and delicacy on the palate with waves of black currant, mulberry, caramel and violets. The tannic structure is firm and the finish elegantly lengthy. Robert Parker felt the wine had extraordinary aromatic expression of liquid minerals/stones in the mouth, yet was remarkably light on its feet. He awarded the 2000 Lafite 100 points. Robert Mondavi was himself here in 1988, and this imperial of his wine from that vintage fittingly celebrates that time. Savor the more wines of Bordeaux, too. Included is a full case of Jean-Michel Cazes outstanding Lynch-Bages 2000. May-Eliane de Lencquesaing shines with the epic 1995 Pichon Lalande, and Prince Robert of Luxembourg is remembered by the 1994 Haut Brion which is an unmistakably spicy, full-bodied, powerful wine with extraordinary balance. It's a pure wine with a notably fine integration of new oak, acidity, and tannin.

Mind-blowingly beautiful Champagne is here, too. Cristal and Dom Pérignon Rosé. Both are meant for special celebrations. Remember our good friend from Burgundy's Louis Jadot? Savor Pierre Henry Gagey's Chapelle Chambertin 2008. Finish—or begin!—with 1983 Château d'Yquem.

Note: One Château d'Yquem bottle is top shoulder level and the Mondavi imperial is base neck level.

Truly, a grand lot in support of grand opera.



1988 Gruaud Larose is another elite powerful red, with wonderful fruit concentration. It presents classic Saint-Julien notes of black currant, cedar, lead pencil and superb concentration and length. The top-notch Château Gruaud Larose ensures quality and a wine that will not disappoint.

Note: One base neck and one top shoulder level Château Gruaud Larose bottles.
